All candidates for At-Large and District Boston City Council seats were asked the following questions:

- 1. Do you support the right to life from conception to natural death?
- 2. Do you support the 2003 decision by the Massachusetts Supreme Judicial Court legalizing same-gender marriage in the Commonwealth?
- 3. Do you support a needle exchange program for drug users in Boston?
- 4. Do you support the 1994 School Committee decision to distribute condoms in Boston Public Schools?
- 5. Do you support efforts by the Governor's Commission on Gay and Lesbian Youth to promote homosexual programs, such as Gay/Straight Alliances, in Boston Public High Schools?
- 6. Do you support the ordinance passed by the Boston City Council in October, 2002, which added "gender identity or expression" to the city's civil rights code?

A position consistent with Catholic moral teaching and supportive of the rights and interests of Catholic parents, families, and taxpayers would require a "YES" response to the first question, and a "NO" response to questions 2 through 6.
